Pre-registration for the second annual Dakota Digital Film Festival (DDFF) is now open to high school and college students and teachers from the region. Inspired from the success of our first event this past March ([view](#)), planning has begun to make the 2013 event an even more extraordinary experience. The Day Session of the festival is FREE for high school and college students and their teachers pre-registered through their schools by January 11, 2013.

The Day Session (8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.) will include workshop presentations by filmmakers and production professionals, screenings and critiques of selected student films, lunch, door prizes and more. Some workshop presentations will include:

- **Creating your Home Studio: A Starting Point for ND Filmmakers** presented by Troy Sterling Nies, Composer for film, stage and television

Additional workshops, presenters, and films will be shared as details are finalized.

Any genre is welcome, but content must be non-commercial and submissions under 5 minutes are preferred. While we encourage all schools to submit films/videos for screening consideration, it is NOT a requirement to attend.

In addition to the Day Session, DDFF will have an Evening Session starting at 7:00 p.m. which will include screenings of award-winning short films and additional networking opportunities. These evening events will be open to the public for a nominal ticket price.
